Meeting with some of the new Cardinals – 6 and 7 December 2024

Tomorrow, **Thursday 5 December 2024**, at **11.30**, a **“Meeting Point”** with journalists will be held at the Holy See Press Office, Via della Conciliazione 54, to present the **new management team of the Pope’s Worldwide Prayer Network**, a papal work created by Pope Francis, on the occasion of the tenth anniversary of its re-founding.
